

Regulations for Establishing the Admissions and Examination Committee of the Department of Physics, NTU

Approved at the Department Affairs Meeting, December 14, 1995

Revised and approved at the Department Affairs Meeting, May 16, 1998

Article 1: The Admissions and Examination Committee (hereafter referred to as “the Committee”) is established based on Article 2 of “the Regulations for the Establishment of Standing Working Committees”.

Article 2: The Committee consists of six members, the term for each member is two years, and half of the committee members will be reelected every academic year. In the final department affairs meeting of each academic year, the attendants shall nominate and elect new members for the next academic year.

Article 3: There will be one convener for the Committee. The original convener should summon all members within two weeks after their election to elect the new convener.

Article 4: Operational items related to admissions and examinations which are not listed in the regulations should be dealt with based on other related regulations of the Office of Academic Affairs of NTU.

Article 5: Final decisions of the Committee should be approved at the Department Affairs Meeting.

Article 6: Regulations will be implemented after approval at the Department Affairs Meeting and after review by NTU. When revisions of regulations are needed, the same procedures shall apply.
